



Leslie L. Squires Foundation Grants

The Leslie L. Squires Foundation was established in 1987 by Jacqueline M. Squires in memory of her late husband, Leslie L. Squires. Both Jacqueline and Leslie were supportive of many civic and charitable organizations. Both also had compassion for people who have disabilities. As a result, the Foundation's charitable purposes seek to improve "the social condition of persons with disabilities through education, entertainment, recreation, and special training in preparation for self-support and the full development of useful, happy lives".

Bay Area Community Foundation administers the grant process for the Leslie L. Squires Foundation. Nonprofit organizations with an IRS 501(c)3 tax status are eligible to apply. Programs and projects will serve Bay County, Michigan children, and/or adults with disabilities. Schools and government entities are not eligible for this grant opportunity.

Spring Applications:

Cycle Opens - Second Monday in January

Letter of Intent Deadline: First Monday in March

Application Submission: Second Monday in March

Grant Review - April/May

Board Approval/Grant Notifications - Second Tuesday in May

Fall Applications:

Cycle Opens - Second Monday in July

Letter of Intent Deadline: First Tuesday in September

Application Submission: Second Monday in September

Grant Review - October

Board Approval/Grant Notifications - Second Tuesday in November
